

morning errand would affect me and my faith journey. He had no clue that his bold obedience in response to the Father's call would not only impact his family, but countless others too.

He built a legacy of faith, one simple act of obedience at a time. Please know that your seemingly mundane choices of daily obedience are building a legacy too. I didn't know what a gift this "burden" would become—trying to figure out how to make an invisible faith visible to my kids. My primary motivation was my kids' faith—it was for their freedom. I had no idea that by leaning into it, I was actually beginning to unwrap my own freedom as well."

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hlights of the Book

Part 1 The Gift Given - Freedom

In this section the author works through her own obstacles that were tripping her up in her quest to figure out the practical part of passing faith on to her kids. She looks at :

- Unrealistic expectations in parenting-her own and the ones placed upon her.
- **The comparison trap** and the importance of chasing contentment instead of coveting. She looks at social media and our addiction to affirmation, as well as the significance of embracing the messiness of community. She provides tools to guard our heart from comparison including practising gratitude and the opportunity we have to leverage our virtual space.
- **Warped views:** about Self lies of the enemy, historical baggage and negative self-talk. About God wrong understanding about who God is and His heart towards her.
- **Successful Parenting** what is that, how do we measure it? Is God even calling us to that? What is He calling us to Faithful vs. Successful parenting.

Part 2 The Gift Unwrapped – Direction

Having worked through some of the obstacles that entangled her, this section addresses; how do you move forward now that you can recognize clearly where you are, and you see where you want to go. What do you need for this length of the journey?

- **Survey of the land** Analyze your calendar; are you still in survival mode, recognize the tyranny of the urgent and how that derails you from your goal. What are your dreams for you family?
- How to build a plan Make a commitment, pray through your home, and how to create a family mission statement.
- Three essentials Putting family first, living counter-cultural, choosing simplicity.

Part 3 The Gift in Action - Intentionality

This is the hands on, super practical portion of the book. It addresses real, tangible ways we can break down a complex invisible faith for our kids to understand. Each chapter addresses some theory and then breaks it down into practical, applicable tools, resources and activities. In this part the author addresses:

- How to **Pray** for our kids and teach them how to pray
- What is the significance of **Blessing** power of words, why bless, how to bless and how to create personal blessings for our kids.

- Sex The significance and value of parents, lies our society has bought into, coming to terms with our own sexual history. How much is too much? Emotional, physical and spiritual cost of sex. How to choose your response before a crisis and equipping your kids with an exit plan.
- **Money** Attitudes to cultivate; our example, stewardship, contentment, trusting God, and generosity. Action to ignite; allowance, budgeting and planning, tithing, and thoughts around debt and plastic.
